

Summary Exercise: Step 3

Take your text from the previous step and extend it by more technical details.

The technical part is for a reader that has a general CS background and mathematical skills, but has probably no knowledge of the particular subject. Help the imagined reader to get into the subject.

Explain the main points in some depth. Make it clear what problems are raised and how they are approached.

(You will have to decide: Which details do you find central and most important to explain? Which details are too special and can be left out?)

Also, further references may be added to the bibliography if appropriate.

Feel free to critically comment on everything: on the subject itself, on proposed concepts and methods, and also on the readability of the sources. But clearly mark your own thoughts and contributions.

Our evaluation criteria are: demonstrated depth of understanding, factual correctness, structure, clarity, coherence, scientific argumentation, proper citations.

The recommended text length so far is 2 – 3 printed pages (excluding the bibliography, and excluding pictures and tables if you have any).
