Examination

Evaluation of students registered in 2015:

- The student is evaluated through two compulsory homework assignments with report submission and oral examination, and a *voluntary written exam*
- The final grade (scale is U, 3, 4, 5) is based on the average grade of the compulsory homework assignments
- The score for each homework assignment must be equivalent to a grade of 3 or above.
- To enable the highest final grade (5) the student must take, and pass, the voluntary written exam (grade: pass or fail)

Voluntary written exam

Preparation guidelines:

- Full in-depth knowledge of examiner's lecture notes
- Overview knowledge of guest lecture notes
(#13, 15, 16: Comm networks, WCET analysis, Clock synch)
- Knowledge of other course material is not required
- Note: *older written exams are not representative*

Books, notes or calculators are **NOT** allowed:

- Numerical calculations (if any) will be fairly simple
- Language dictionaries (printed) are allowed
- Electronic language translators are not allowed
